## Improvements and New Features

- **Improved Control Over Customized Columns**

Custom columns can now be individually selected for migration or exclusion in a Migration Profile. When creating new custom columns, users can now select a file type for the content of each customized column.

- **New Pre-Migration Scanner**

Website Migrator 2.0 includes a Pre-Migration Scanner which can provide a detailed analysis of the Migration Plan before it is run. The Scanner will report information such as the content types, page templates, and site hierarchies which will be migrated.

- **Website Migrator 2.0 Certified for Windows 7**

Website Migrator 2.0 has passed Microsoft-designed tests for compatibility and reliability on Windows 7.

## Bug Fixes

- **Resolved Table to SharePoint list Migration Error**

Website Migrator can now migrate HTML tables to convenient SharePoint lists with full data fidelity. Previously, column-head data was not captured and migrated.

- **Site Migration Plan File Name Changes**

Please note that after a migration plan has been run, the Site Migration Plan (.SMP) filename you have created may be shortened or changed. This has been found to have no effect on the content or functionality of the .SMP file.



## **Known Issues**

- **Entering in Website IP Address in Place of Site URL**

Website Migrator's Web Service currently does not support entering in a website's IP address (for example: 127.0.0.1) in place of its given URL. If necessary, this can be resolved by adding the site IP address to the host file.

- **Unsupported Items listed when Creating New Migration Profile**

During the creation of a new Migration Profile, certain file types which are not supported for migration will still be listed. Contents of a typical website server which cannot be migrated include any associated databases, any logical processes running in the background of the site, and any Active-X objects or controllers.
